



Taking the energy and grace of the human body as her starting point Jennine creates masterly bronze evocations of life.

"My passion is the human form, and before I start a piece I create as many life drawings as possible. This encourages strong observation and is the foundation of my work."











"I prefer to work in clay, the feeling of the texture and the way you can manipulate the clay is very entrancing. But before I start each piece I have think about what material I need to work in. Although I prefer working in clay, sometimes depending on the complexity of the piece, I might need to work in wax, but I can't always get the finish I need so I have to weigh up what would work best for the finished piece. I always start with a wire armature and build on it, if I am using wax it is much easier to manipulate and change my work; also the wax requires less maintenance as it does not dry out. If I work in clay I have to spray the piece with water and keep it covered, otherwise it will dry out and be difficult to work with. Once the piece is completed, it goes to the foundry to be translated into bronze. The type of base and how the piece will be assembled is also important to me - it's not just about sculpting - it's looking at the whole process through every stage, to create the final sculpture."










LIBERATION I
